

## Thank you for purchasing a Krivo Pickup for Gypsy Jazz Guitar



To install your pickup follow these easy instructions :  
Take two small BB or lentil sized pieces of the included putty and apply one piece to each end of your pickup as shown in the photo below.



Flatten the putty with your thumbs till it is very thin, It takes VERY LITTLE putty to solidly affix the pickup to the Guitar. If you use too much it makes a mess and increases the height of the pickup which can interfere with your playing technique and make the strings hit the top of the pickup.



Place the pickup under the strings and gently press it into place with a light rocking motion. For adjustable pole models align poles one under each string (you may need to angle the pickup to make this happen).



Experiment with placement. Closer to the bridge produces a brighter sound and closer to the neck produces a warmer sound. See what works best for your technique.



For Flat top and Single Coil models make sure the black stripe is under the B String. This will ensure that you have proper string balance and avoid the hot B string associated with traditional Gypsy pickups.  
Now plug in a standard 1/4in guitar cable between the pickup and your amp and you are ready to play.



For adjustable pole models use the included hex wrench to adjust poles for perfect string balance. To make a particular string quieter tighten the pole by turning clockwise and thereby increasing the distance between pole and string. To make a string louder loosen the pole turning counter clockwise and bring the pole closer to the string.

**Important:** Do not overtighten the poles. If you use excessive force you may damage the pickup. If it seems you have run out of space you may need to use a shorter set screw ( I can provide them for you).
